Welcome to this Bluegrass performance by mandolinist Jacob Jolliff and his incredible band. If you haven't heard his recent 2024 album, *Instrumentals, Vol. 2: Mandolin Mysteries*, I highly encourage you to give it a listen. As a native Angeleno, I appreciated my hometown namecheck in *Los Angeles County Breakdown*, which is wonderfully intricate with superb playing. *The Devil Hath Power to Assume a Pleasing Shape* starts off with a lurching off-kilter opening and then draws you along to some unexpected musical places. *The Perils of Macramé* instantly became one of my favorite song titles, and *The Art Heist Suite* does some crafty storytelling of its own over the course of three tracks. This is music to savor and explore, so check it out if you haven't already!

Whether you are a life-long fan of bluegrass or just now discovering this beautiful genre, be sure to mark your calendar for the River Raisin Americana Celebration, which will take place on April 26 right here in the theater at the River Raisin Centre for the Arts. Our collaborative partners Ashleigh Glass-Cooper and Cody Cooper will be putting out a call for musical artists soon, so look for the River Raisin Americana Celebration on Facebook or visit riverraisinamericana.com. JACOB JOLLIFF BAND

Jacob Jolliff's musical journey began at just seven years old when his father handed him a mandolin. Little did they know, this small beginning was the spark for something extraordinary. His early immersion in bluegrass gospel with his father's band saw him traverse the northwest, performing at festivals and churches, and rubbing elbows with legends like Ronnie McCoury and Chris Thile. This whirlwind of early exposure to great musicians inspired him to push boundaries and pursue his craft with relentless enthusiasm.

At 18, Jacob's talent earned him a coveted scholarship to The Berklee College of Music, where he honed his skills under the mentorship of mandolin maestro John McGann. His college years were a blend of intense practice and thrilling performances, including a notable stint with Joy Kills Sorrow, a band that took him across North America and Europe. By 2012, Jacob's prowess was crowned with a National Mandolin Championship win. The following years saw him embark on a new adventure with the Yonder Mountain String Band, where his musical synergy and personal connection with the group propelled him into the spotlight. Now leading The Jacob Jolliff Band, Jacob continues to mesmerize audiences with his original compositions and dynamic performances, both in the U.S. and abroad. In 2022, he joined Béla Fleck's My Bluegrass Heart, sharing stages with some of the genre's finest talents, marking yet another exhilarating chapter in his ever-evolving musical odyssey.
